Call to Order: The meeting was called to order by Supervisor, Victoria Dennett at 7:00pm.

2. Pay all bills that have been submitted that are not on the approved list. There are none.
3. Ramp/deck repair. Jeremy Bonnett contacted Victoria Dennett and said he will start work the 2nd week in June.
4. Victoria Dennett was going to present the contract for Lincoln Township Fire for \$18,767.00; Ashley already paid it.
5. Update on Horse camp. Victoria Dennett contacted someone about the horse camp and they said that it probably will not be completed until next year because paperwork is holding up the process.
6. Discussion on ending taking tires at Large Item pickup. Victoria Dennett presented a flyer from Osceola Lake Conservation District for the 1st Annual Scrap Tire Collection in June 2026. Victoria suggested that we take tires at this year's large item pickup, but discontinue it for next year, as she thought the Conservation District will continue the scrap tire collection. Robert Visner mentioned that we should give residents all opportunities to clean up their properties. The board did not vote on this.
