Call to Order: The meeting was called to order by Supervisor, Victoria Dennett at 7:00pm.

Assessor's Report: Molly Whetstone was not in attendance.

Commissioner's Report: Kristine Raymond was in attendance. Kristine handed out many pamphlets regarding different events, clean up opportunities, and health programs in Lake County.
